Families allowed to meet with Camp Dodge detainees

Family members are being allowed to visit their loved ones detained at Camp Dodge for the first time since Tuesday's raid.

Visiting hours are from noon to 6 p.m.

Those visiting must have photo identification and legal documentation to be in the country. Three family members are allowed visitation at a time, and visits are limited to 15-minute increments.

A couple with a small child approached the Camp Dodge gates around 2:45 p.m. and was eventually admitted after a brief exchange with ICE officials.
